### Position Description / Summary

There are 3 medical oncology registrars at the Alfred Hospital. The unit sees general oncology patients with an emphasis on common malignancies with particular interest in G.I., Lung, CNS malignancies, Melanoma and Head and Neck cancers. The Alfred has a Radiotherapy department and a Palliative Care Unit. The 3 Units work closely together often co-ordinating combined modality treatments.

All haematological malignancies are managed by the Haematology unit.

There are 9 Multidisciplinary meetings per week.

The registrars attend 5 outpatient clinics per week seeing new patients, patients on chemotherapy and general reviews. The 3 registrars rotate monthly between wards (responsible for inpatients), clinic and day centre, clinic and referrals.

There are 3 consultant ward rounds per week.

On call is 1 in 3, rotating on a weekly basis between the 3 medical oncology registrars.

It is likely that 1 of the positions will be a 6 month rotation with a more peripheral hospital.

See all medical oncology consults in a timely manner (when on referrals)  
Supervise junior medical staff and medical students  
1 in 3 after hours on call  
Manage complications in the oncology day centre
