

Top Preference Filter Functionality - Intern Match



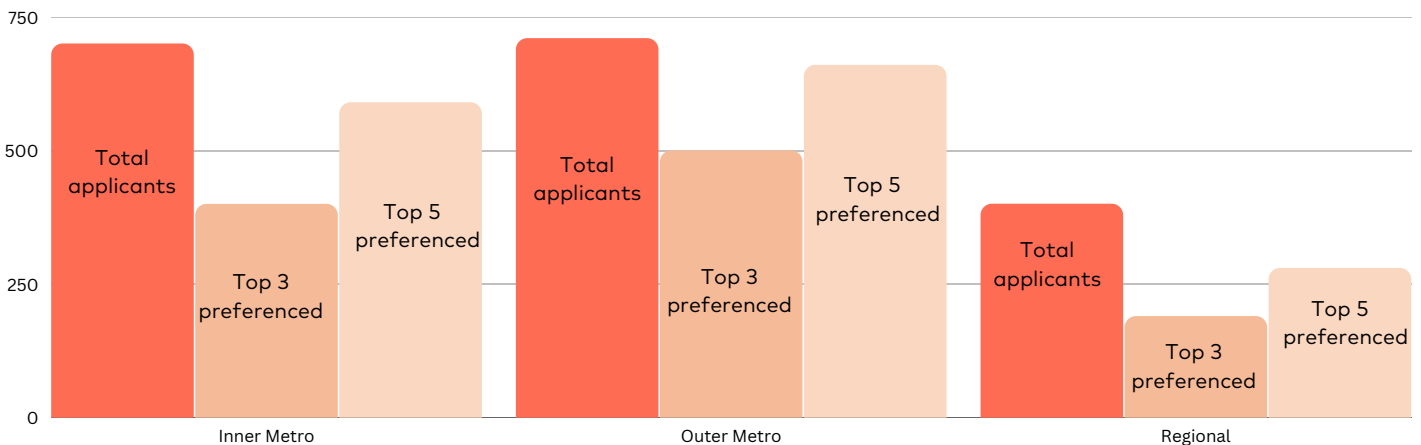
PMCV introduced the top preference filter functionality in 2021 as a tool for health services to use whilst screening candidates for the Intern Match. Health Services cannot see candidates' actual preference order, only if you have preferred the Health Service within your in the top 3 or top 5 preferences.

PMCV surveyed all Victorian Health Services on how they use the top preference filter function in the Intern Match. We received 17 responses, and their answers are as follows:

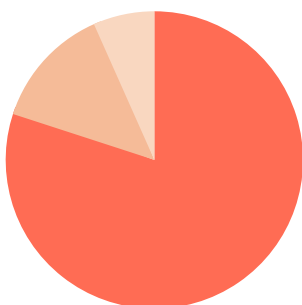
- 6 responses from Metro Hospitals
- 4 responses from Regional Hospitals
- 7 responses from Rural Hospitals
