HMO = Hospital Medical Officer, BPT1&2 = Basic Physician Training years 1 and 2, RG2 = Rural Generalist Year 2

Pre-Match Offers

HMO pre-Match offers are for internal appointments only, i.e., a doctor working in a Victorian health service in 2023 continuing with the same employing health service in 2024.

RG2 pre-match offers may only be made to existing RG1 trainees on a defined training pathway. The pre-match may include other Health Services within the same region, to obtain the rotations required for the RG pathway.

Monday 8 May to Friday 19 May	Pre-Match offer Contracts period Candidates to be sent contracts to be signed and returned to Health Services.
Friday 26 May	Pre-match offer period Closes (Candidates and Health Services) Health Services to report all pre-match offers to PMCV by Friday 26 May
