

PMCV Term Description Template and Guideline: Prevocational Outcome Statements

Communique 24th July 2023

The Postgraduate Medical Council of Victoria (PMCV) has sought clarification from the Australian Medical Council (AMC) regarding the minimum requirement in relation to completing section three, 'Outcome statements', of the [PMCV Term Description template](#).

[The national standards for prevocational training programs and terms](#) which are to be used from 2024 by Postgraduate Medical Councils to accredit health services providing training programs for PGY1 and PGY2 doctors notes the following:

Domain 2: Training program – structure and content

Standard 2.2.2: *'For each term, the prevocational training provider has identified and documented the training requirements (see Training and assessment requirements for prevocational (PGY1 and PGY2) training programs: Section 2 – 'Prevocational training'), **including the prevocational outcome statements that are relevant**, the skills and procedures that can be achieved, and the nature and range of clinical experience available to meet these objectives.'*

On the basis of standard 2.2.2, it is a mandatory requirement for all clinical units to complete section three, 'Outcome statements' of the PMCV Term Description template indicating which prevocational outcome statements could be achieved during that term.
