PMCV Review and Endorsement Process of PGY2 Term Descriptions, Rotation Planners and new PGY2 posts.

Background

From 2025, all PGY2 training programs nationwide are required to meet the requirements of the Australian Medical Council's (AMC) revised National Framework for Prevocational Medical Training (National Framework).

PMCV has collaborated with several stakeholder groups to consider the implications of the National Framework, which has resulted in the decision that the traditional PGY2 streaming approach used in many Victorian health services will be superseded by the requirement for prevocational doctors to meet the AMC Clinical Experience classifications.

Health service submission process

Health services are required to submit PGY2 Term Descriptions including relevant evidence to support the Clinical Experience classification/s (if required), service rotation descriptions and PGY2 Planners, via the NFPMT Implementation Checklist. The nominated National Framework Health Service Lead will receive instructions on how to access the NFPMT Implementation Checklist via email.

National Framework Health Service Leads are required to nominate one or two individuals to be responsible for the upload of documents to PMCV for review. Once these individuals have been appointed, please provide their name and email address to PMCV via NFPMT@pmcv.com.au PMCV will onboard the nominees to the system and provide further instructions.

By 1st of August 2024, health services must submit all PGY2 Term Descriptions (vocational and non-vocational) and evidence to support the Clinical Experience classification to PMCV for review.

By 1st of September 2024, health services must submit PGY2 Rotation Planners to PMCV for review.

Please note:

Health services that have previously submitted PGY2 Term Descriptions are requested to review and resubmit via the NFPMT Implementation Checklist to ensure they meet the guidelines.

To assist with an efficient review process, please ensure the provision of sufficient evidence documents substantiating the allocation of Clinical Experience/s, and that appropriate guidelines are specifically addressed within post applications and/or Term Descriptions.

Please note, not all guideline points need to be addressed if not relevant.

PMCV review and endorsement process

A PMCV Accreditation Sub-committee has been established to review all new PGY2 post applications, Terms Descriptions, service rotation descriptions and PGY2 Planners.

An outcome of review letter will be provided by the PMCV Accreditation Sub-committee via email within six weeks of submission (estimated). Process maps are available for your review on the PMCV website.

Guidance and support

PMCV acknowledges that this is a significant change in Victoria that will require adjustment by some individual doctors, hospital workforce units and clinical units.

Support and guidance will be provided to health services and doctors to assist with understanding and implementing this change.
