FAQ Intern 2026 Recruitment

The following guide has been created to support interns in their application process for an internship at Portland District Health.

How many intern positions will Portland District Health have for 2026?

Portland District Health will have 2 full-time intern positions in 2026.

What rotations are available in 2026?

Rotations are structured into 2 terms, each with 4 rotations, meeting the National Framework for Prevocational Medical Training. Interns must complete 47 weeks of supervised practice across the year.

- General Medicine
- General Surgery
- Emergency Medicine
- General Practice

Does Portland District Health offer part-time internship positions?

Currently, Portland District Health does not offer part-time internships.

How do I apply for an intern position at Portland District Health?

Intern positions are allocated through the PMCV Match Process. To apply, candidates must submit their application via the PMCV Match Process.

What criteria will Portland District Health use to select 2026 interns?

Applications will be assessed based on the following:

- PMCV application form
- Cover letter, CV, and reference checks
- Video interview

Will Portland District Health be conducting interviews for interns?

No, Portland District Health will not conduct interviews for intern positions. The PMCV will conduct online interviews, which form part of the selection criteria.

Will I be required to do night duty?

Interns are not rostered for night duty.

What about orientation?

Portland District Health provides a week of orientation before you begin your first clinical shift.

Is accommodation provided for interns at Portland District Health?

Interns are responsible for organizing their own accommodation, but Portland District Health will reimburse a set fee per week.
